PWC Seed Library Coalition

GCM has always had an eye on the future for opportunities to serve or beautify Montclair and surrounding neighborhoods. We have successfully applied for 12 months of sustaining grant money to fund the existing and quickly growing Seed Library initiative found in several local libraries in PWC. This collaborative project between local garden clubs, the Master Gardener Program, and the PWC Library System is designed to expand the existing seed libraries housed in Montclair, Chinn Park, Central, Potomac, and Haymarket-Gainesville Libraries. Garden clubs feature trained and certified Master Gardeners who can help inspire, educate, and grow a community network of home gardens and gardeners to address food insecurity in the county. Free seeds will also be shared to grow pollinator plants integral to successful gardens. Volunteers will be asked to help with cataloging and replenishing seed collections at libraries and helping to develop educational materials and programs.... and lots more!
